Set on a large area of 220 hectares, 53 of which are dedicated to vineyards and 40 olive trees, it has the typical characteristics of the

PHILOSOPHY: The guidelines of organic agriculture are followed and the full range of wines will be certified organic by 2020. Only sulfur- and copper-based products are used. Only organic fertilizers are used (there is a cattle farm nearby for manure). The soil between the rows of vines is tilled and no herbicides are used. Minimum dosages of SO2 is used in the wines.
