Barricas wines are produced with hand-harvested grapes from Tunuyan and Tupungato in the Uco Valley of Mendoza, one of Argentina's top wine regions.

Winemaker Jose Hinojosa conveys a varietal typicity in his Cabernet Sauvignon and Malbec.
