For 150 years we have been located between Barolo and Monforte d'Alba, on the famous Bussia hill, surrounded by vineyards which curve this Unesco's World Heritage landscape: the Langhe. The winery was founded in 1874 by Luigi Arnulfo, considered the pioneer of Barolo wine for his innovative ideas in the enological world and international wine market. The wine is the sum of several factors: geology, climate, wisdom, hard work, cares and perseverance. In Costa Bussia winery all these factors come together to give their best.
