THE FACTS

COUNTRY: France

REGION: Bordeaux

APPELLATION: Saint-Emilion Grand Cru

CEPAGE: 50% Merlot, 34% Cabernet Franc, 16% Cabernet Sauvignon

WINEMAKING: Picked and then sorted by hand, the harvested fruit is received in 21 temperature-controlled oak vats. After a 38-day vatting period, the malolactic fermentation is carried out in barrels.

AGING: 75% new barrels and 25% second-fill barrels

THE STORY

The history of this estate stretches back centuries, with vines thriving on the slopes of what is now Château Pavie as early as the 4th century. Since March 1998, Chantal and Gérard Perse have owned this illustrious property, classified as a Premier Grand Cru Classé "A." Renowned for its exceptional Saint-Émilion terroir, Château Pavie produces wines celebrated for their structure and elegance, achieved through meticulously limited yields of just 31 hl/ha.
