CEPAGE: 100% Pinot Noir

WINEMAKING: The grapes are harvested manually. The vinification is traditional with 95% de-stemming, cold maceration for 3 to 5 days, then about 15 days fermentation.

ALCOHOL BY VOLUME: 13.0%

AGING: 18 months in oak barrels (40% new)

ANNUAL PRODUCTION: 3500 bottles
