THE STORY

Calvet, one of the oldest French wine brands in the world, was founded in 1818 by Jean-Marie Calvet. In 1849, Jean-Marie and his son Octave built warehouses and opened an office in Bordeaux, they later expanded to Burgundy in 1870 to become the largest wine company in France in the 19th and most of the 20th century.

In 2021, after a successful reimplementation of the Calvet Crémant in all US states, Les Grands Chais de France & Jean-Christophe Calvet reinforced their partnership by enabling the Calvet family to have their own exclusive brand - JC. Calvet Brut Classic and Rose, now being the only exclusive Calvet Crémant in the US market.
