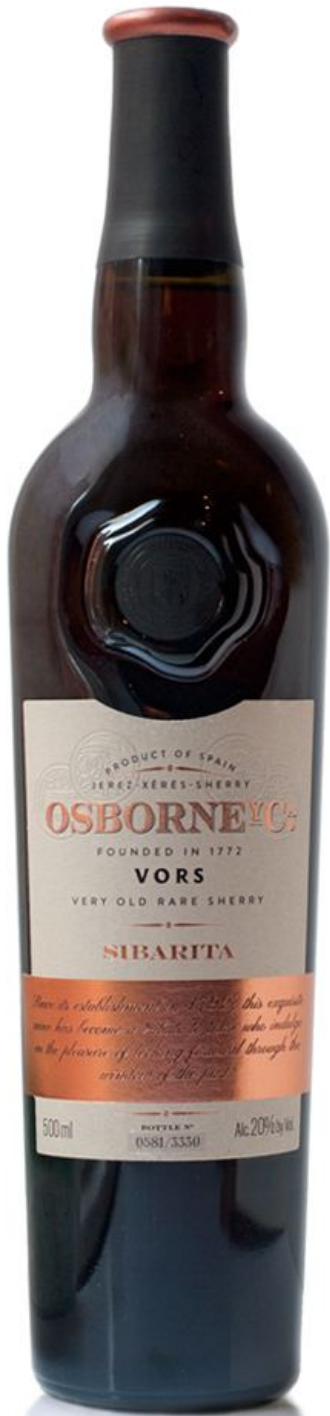


# Bodegas Osborne Vors Sibarita Oloroso 1792



## THE FACTS

COUNTRY: Spain

REGION: Andalucia

APPELLATION: Jerez

CEPAGE: 98% Palomino, 2% Pedro Ximenez

WINEMAKING: 30 years of age at bottling (on average) from 4 criaderas founded in 1792. RS = 0 g/L

## THE STORY

Osborne is one of the most renowned names in the history of Sherry, Brandy. They created the iconic silhouette of the huge black bull that can be seen from the rolling hilltops across Spain to signify their family-owned brands as a way to honor Spanish culture and tradition. The venerable history was initiated by Englishman Thomas Osborne, who started shipping his Sherries in 1804.

## THE ADJECTIVES

AROMAS / FLAVORS: Toffee notes intermixed with roasted coffee, tar, ash and incense

MOUTHFEEL: Deep with strong acidity

## THE SELLING POINTS

PAIRINGS: Dishes that incorporate figs, dates, maple syrup, chocolate and soy sauce, or curried dishes
