

Rewa Khanda Cabernet Sauvignon

THE FACTS

COUNTRY: USA - CA

REGION: Napa

APPELLATION: Coombsville

CEPAGE: 76% Cabernet Sauvignon, 14% Cabernet Franc, 10% Malbec

WINEMAKING: The grapes for this wine were grown entirely on the Rewa Estate on the eastern benches of Coombsville, Napa Valley. Harvested between September 6th and September 26th, 2021, each portion of the small vineyard was fermented separately, then transferred to French Oak barrels- 60% new. A blend of 76% Cabernet Sauvignon, 14% Cabernet Franc, and 10% Malbec, the blend spent 21 months in French Oak barrels prior to bottling in July 2023.

ANNUAL PRODUCTION: A total of 352 cases were produced.

THE STORY

Acquired by Gajendra Singh Sareen in 2012, Rewa is located in Coombsville just east of Downtown Napa. Legendary winemaker Celia Welch helms winemaking.

Production remains small, with only around 700 cases of wine released each year.

PHILOSOPHY: The soil must express itself, simply and clearly, as great wine.
