THE FACTS

COUNTRY: Australia

REGION: Western Australia

APPELLATION: Margaret River

CEPAGE: 100% Chardonnay

WINEMAKING: Hand harvested fruit was cooled and destemmed, before being held on skins and combined with components of whole bunch pressed parcels. The juice was settled for 12-36 hours, racked and inoculated with yeast. 100% of the juice was barrel fermented in new French oak barriques and the lees stirred regularly. After 11 months in barrels, the various components were blended, fined, stabilised and bottled.

AGING: 10 months in 100% new French Oak
